

How to look after your new turf

If you have recently laid turf to your garden, it is essential to immediately set about a maintenance programme to enable the grass to become established.

- Thoroughly soak the new turf until moist on the underside
- A hosepipe and sprinkler are recommended for this, as purely a hose pipe or watering can will not provide a sufficient amount
- Never allow your new turf to dry out or shrink as this will be permanent
- Ensure your lawn is thoroughly saturated for a period of approximately 2 weeks, and this means watering on a daily basis
- The amount of water is dependent on the season, but do not allow the lawn to be waterlogged
- Also never allow your grass to become too long before the first mowing and use the highest setting for the first few cuts
- Do not walk on the lawn until firm underfoot
